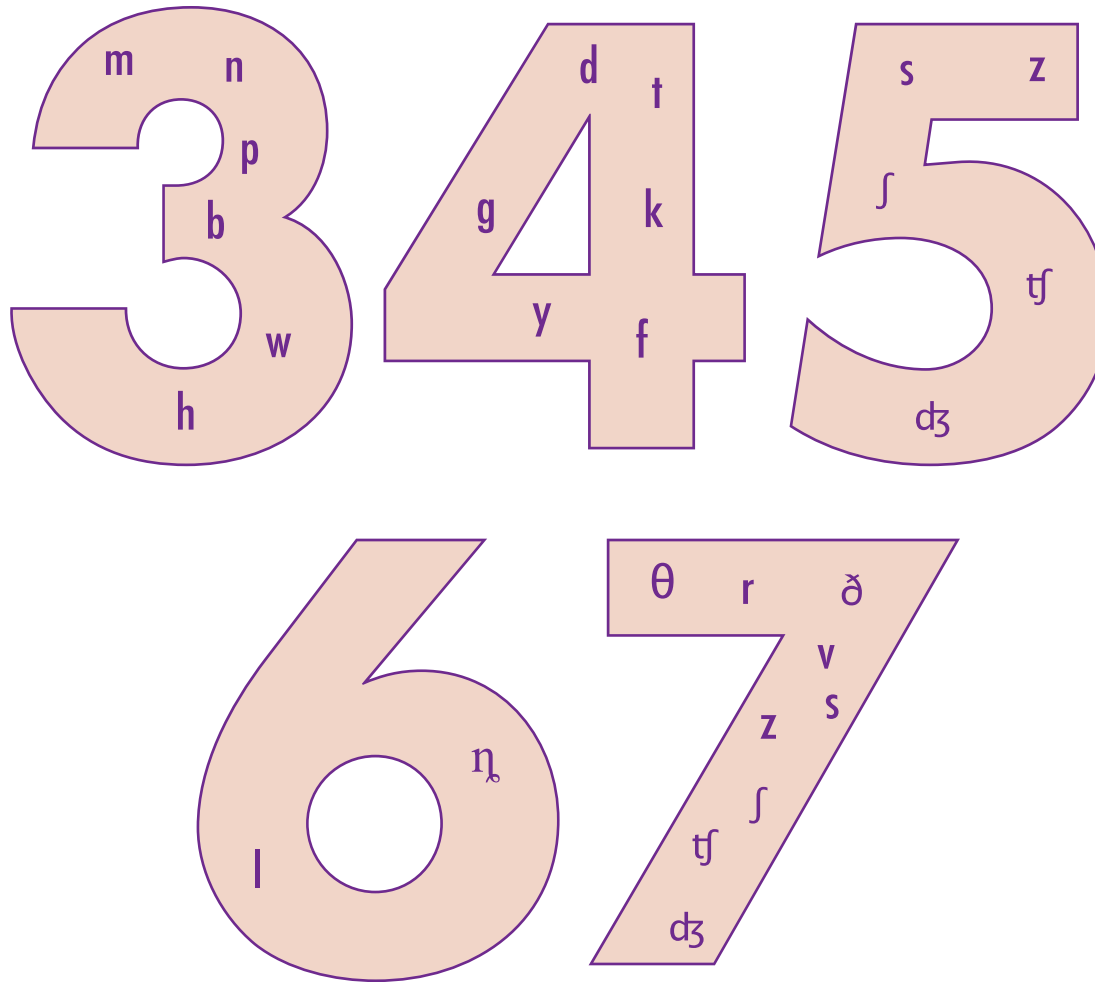


DEVELOPMENTAL ARTICULATION



English Articulation Phoneme Development (as cited in Communication Severity Scale, North Inland SELPA, 2007).

/ʃ/ as in shoe

/θ/ unvoiced "th" as in thumb

/tʃ/ as in chair

/ð/ "th" voiced in this

/dʒ/ as in jam

/ŋ/ as in ring

** Please note that phonemes developing at age five are emerging, and not expected to be fully stable until age 7.
