

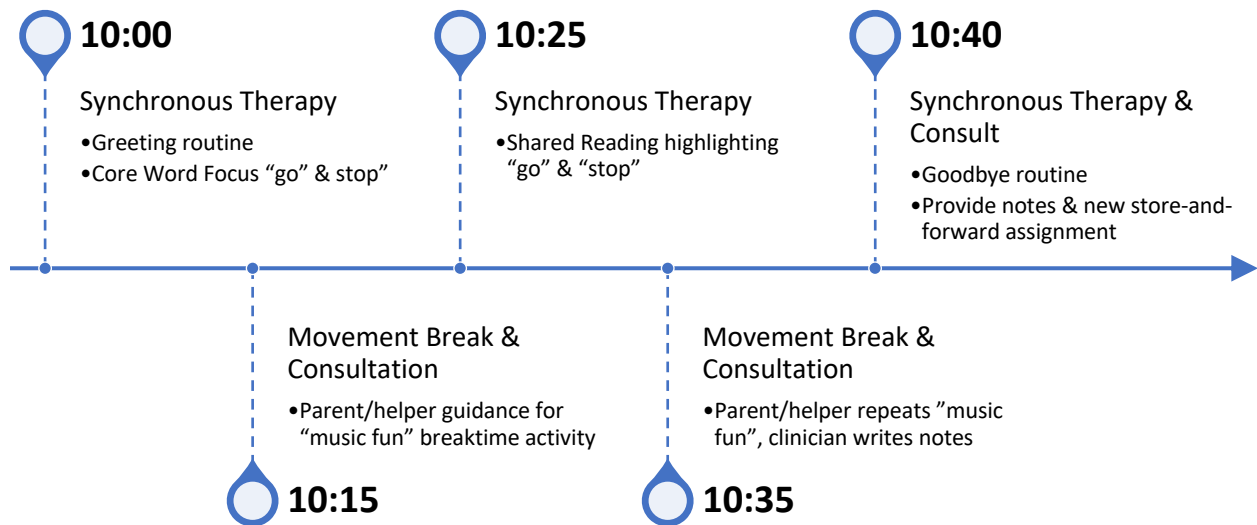

Quick Glance

Synchronous Session	Real-time virtual interaction Mimics onsite interaction
Asynchronous Session	Time Delayed virtual interaction Clinician provided videos, websites, links, and virtual materials Clinician provided specific guidance May include Store-and-Forward parent/helper provided recording & information
Store-and-Forward	Parent/Helper captures student in real-life situations Audio and/or video recording Sent to clinician to review prior to next scheduled session
Instructional Phone Calls	May be used to clarify instructional activities May be used for team collaboration
Instructional Curriculum-Based	Hard Copies of materials delivered to families
Hybrid Session	Combination of above models Percentages of each model may vary depending upon student and family needs May be implemented within session, or within weekly/monthly Schedule (See examples below)
Flexible Service Model	Fluid, flexible process that shifts according to family needs, e.g.: all Asynchronous, then add some Synchronous service
